CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING - LESSONS

Cross-Country Group Lessons Daily 10:00 am - 11:30 am

Join our skilled Nordic instructors for a cross-country group lesson. Learn to ski and enjoy the serenity of the Vermont Winter woods. *\$45 per person.*

Cross-Country Private Lessons Daily 11:45 am - 12:45 pm

Get personalized instruction in cross-country ski techniques from our skilled instructors. *\$60 per person, \$40 each additional person (up to 3 people), equipment not included. By appointment.*

Mom or Dad & Me Private Lessons Daily 11:45 am - 12:45 pm

You and your child can learn to cross-country ski together with personalized lessons from our instructors. Parent with child age 6 & older, *\$80 per lesson, equipment not included. By appointment.*

Back Country Lesson Fri. 12:00 noon - 2:00 pm

Get off the beaten path on a scenic rolling back country tour. This is a low angle slow-paced tour over gradual terrain. Expect plenty of surprise and fun play spots along the way. Should be a confident cross country or telemark skier. *\$45 per person, equipment not included.*

SNOWSHOEING - LESSONS

Join us for 1½ hour daily group snowshoe lessons, learn the basic techniques of snowshoeing and back-country terrain tactics. In addition to a basic lesson, a variety of topics and snowshoe destinations are explored during the week. Sign-up and discover the wonderful world of Winter.

Our Forest Heritage Trek ● Sun. 10:00 am - 11:30 am

Explore Vermont's local history as you snowshoe through the fields and forest surrounding Smugglers'. Learn about the history of Vermont and its forest animals: find the Black Bear's favorite beech trees, discover signs of resident deer and moose. *\$45 per person, equipment provided.*

Winter Survival Trek ● Mon. 10:00 am - 11:30 am & Wed. 1:00 pm - 2:30 pm

Have you ever wondered what you might need to know to survive outdoors in the Winter? Learn some essential Winter camping survival skills and tips on how to provide food, warmth, and shelter from the cold on this fun and adventurous trek. *\$45 per person, equipment provided.*

Vermont Experience ● Tues. & Fri. 10:00 am - 11:30 am

Explore the quiet beauty of our wooded trails as you search for animal tracks, learn about local history and take in the scenery of the dramatic Vermont Winter landscape. *\$45 per person, equipment provided.*

Where's the Bear? Trek ● Thurs. 10:00 am - 11:30 am

One of the most magnificent and interesting, yet elusive animals that makes this area its home, is the Black Bear. Learn more about the variety of habitat that a Black Bear might use during a yearly seasonal cycle, what types of plants and animals support these seasonal activities and why we hardly see them. *\$45 per person, equipment provided.*

Beaver Pond Trek ● Sat. 10:00 am - 11:30 am

Explore the wonders of the beaver ponds and the scenery of the dramatic Vermont Winter landscape. *\$45 per person, equipment provided.*

Private cross-country or snowshoe guided adventures. *\$160 per hour for up to 4 people, equipment included.*

High Elevation Snowshoe Tour ■ Mon. & Thurs. 12:00 noon - 2:00 pm

Ride to the top of the Morse lift, explore untracked trails with breathtaking views. Mondays trek descends gradually to the base of Madonna Mountain and Thursdays trek descends to the base of Whiteface Mountain. Beginners welcome! *\$45 per person, equipment and lift access provided.*

Maple Experience Snowshoe Trek ■ Tues. 12:00 noon - 2:00 pm

Join us on a guided trek through Vermont's pristine woods and learn about the liquid gold that runs through our maple trees. Learn to identify the different types of maple trees and techniques involved in maple sugaring, a time honored Vermont tradition. Bring home a sample of pure maple syrup. *\$48 per person, equipment provided.*

Snowshoe Adventure Dinner ■ Tues. 4:14 pm - 8:30 pm

18 & older. The Sterling lift transports you to The Top of The Notch, a mountain cabin lit only by candles. Enjoy a gourmet meal with appetizer, salad, choice of main course and dessert. After dinner, work off those calories with a 40 minute snowshoe down to the Base Lodge.

Advance registration at The Guest Service Desk or Nordic Desk is required. Sign-up deadline is Tuesday at 12:00 noon. Minimum sign-up is required for trip to run. Transportation to the Base Lodge leaves from the Village Welcome Sign at 4:15 pm. Function will be cancelled in the event of severe weather. *\$69 per person, includes lift access, snowshoe rental, and dinner.*

Moonlight Mile Night Skiing ■ Tues. 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm

Kick and glide into the tranquil night on a lantern lit trail. This tour, led by Nordic guide PK, will follow rolling terrain along beginner and intermediate trails. Enjoy the memorable experience of skiing by moonlight under Vermont's starry skies. Participants will be equipped with LED head lamps on nights with less ambient light. *\$35 per person, equipment provided.*

Back Country Tour ■ Wed. & Sat. 12:00 noon - 2:00 pm

Explore the undisturbed Smugglers' Notch back country that few ever get to see. You'll get a completely unique look at the sheer beauty and majesty of the Notch formation from your vantage point below the Notch Road. *\$45 per person, equipment provided.*

Snowshoe Notch Night Tour ■ Sat. 7:00 pm - 9:00 pm

Take a moonlight snowshoe trip into Smugglers' Notch with our Nordic staff and enjoy the serenity of the Winter woods at night. *\$35 per person, equipment provided.*

S'mores & Snowshoes Trek ■ Wed. 5:30 pm - 6:30 pm

Join us for a guided family snow shoe trek on a lantern lit section of our trails ending at our bonfire pit for a tasty s'mores treat. *\$20 per person, equipment provided.*

Fireworks & Snowshoes Tour ● Thurs. 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm

Snowshoe adventures are even more exciting when you top off your trek by watching the Village fireworks light up the sky from your special vantage point. *\$35 per person, equipment provided.*

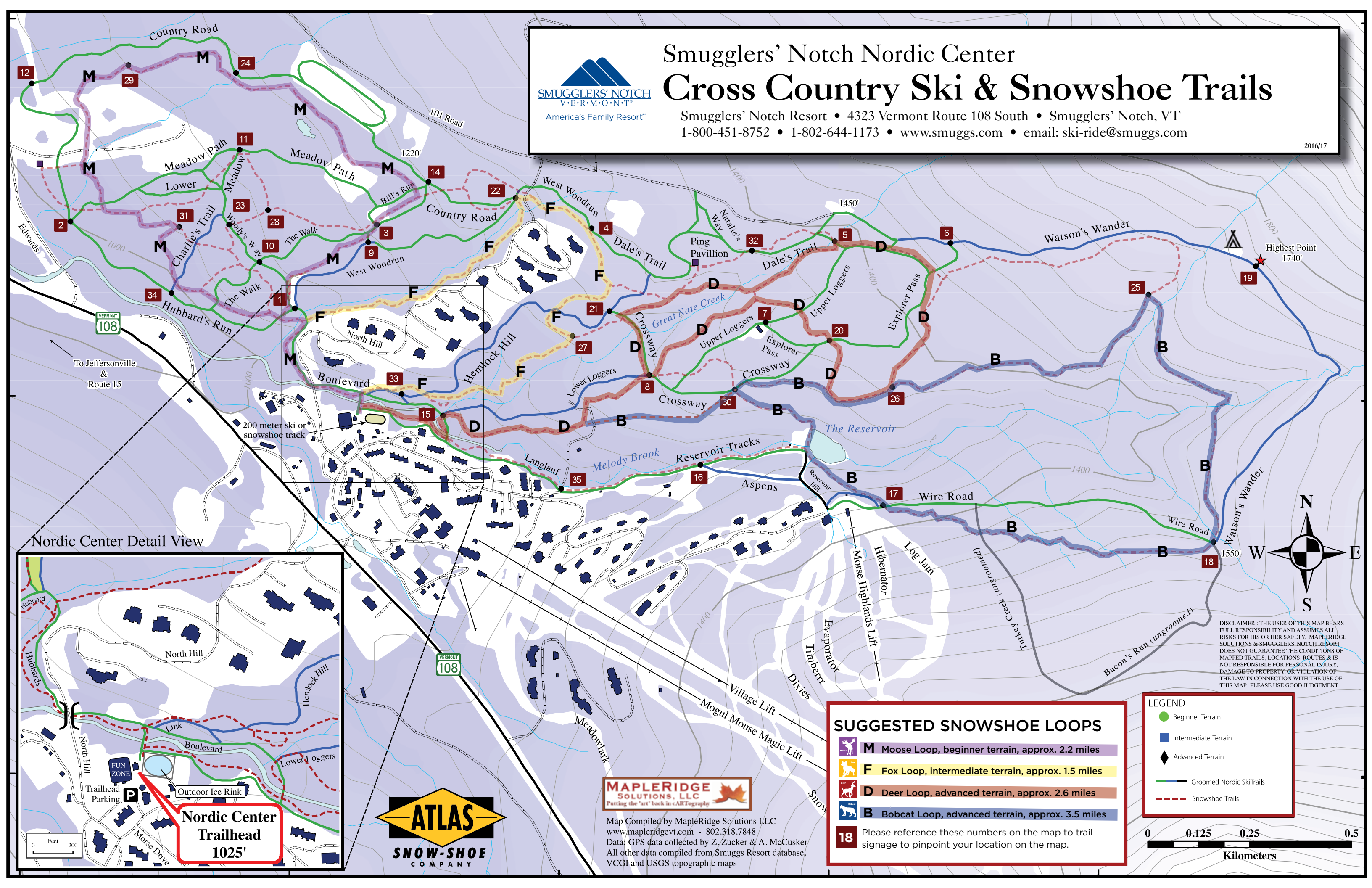




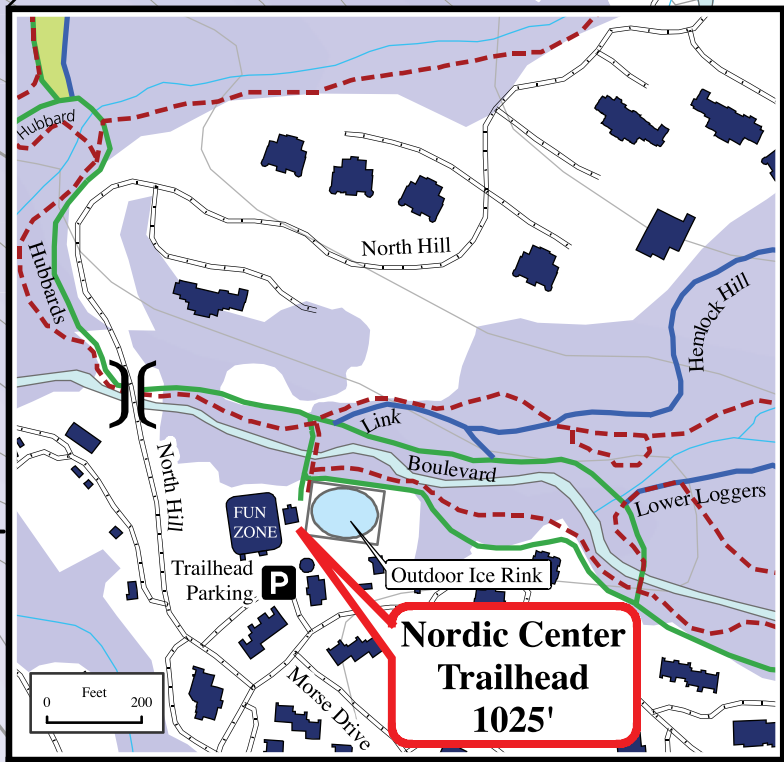

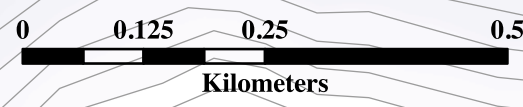
SUGGESTED SNOWSHOE LOOPS
