

Participating in snow sports carries inherent risks. Please be aware of changing trail conditions caused by weather, skier and snowboarder use, snowmaking, grooming, and other activities. Mountain Operations are active 24 hours a day, so you may encounter grooming equipment or utility vehicles on the trails at any time. All terrain at Smugglers' Notch contains both man-made and natural obstacles/hazards. While we use various marking devices to indicate potential risks, not all will be marked. It is your responsibility to avoid both marked and unmarked obstacles and hazards. Exercise common sense, show courtesy to others, and be prepared for hazardous situations. The National Ski Area Association's Responsibility Code outlines ten key points for snow sport safety.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE

- 1 Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
- 2 People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
- 3 Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
- 4 Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
- 5 You must prevent runaway equipment.
- 6 Read and obey all signs, warnings and hazard markings.
- 7 Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- 8 You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
- 9 Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
- 10 If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and Ski Patrol. **Know and Obey the Code. Your personal safety is your responsibility.** If you need help understanding the Code, please ask Ski Patrol.

OFF TRAIL POLICY - Within Resort Boundaries
Wooded areas between named trails and glades are not marked in any way, are not patrolled and have no skier/snowboarder services. If you decide to ski or snowboard in wooded areas, within the ski area boundary, you are solely responsible for yourself. You should be an expert skier/snowboarder and you should stay in groups of three or more.

OFF TRAIL POLICY - Outside Resort Boundaries
Skiing/Snowboarding beyond the resort boundary, as shown on this map, should only be attempted by expert skiers knowledgeable in winter backcountry travel. Terrain beyond the resort boundary is not maintained or monitored by Ski Patrol. Pursuant to 12 V.S.A. 1038, Smugglers' is not responsible for any injury or death. Additionally, participants will be responsible for any expense incurred to provide rescue, medical, or other services.

UPHILL TRAVEL POLICY
Uphill traffic is allowed during specific times and areas. No uphill traffic is allowed during operational hours. Please visit smuggs.com/uphilltravel for the complete Uphill Travel policy.
